

Call for Abstracts: 50th Anniversary Annual Scientific Meeting
The Hilton Tower Bridge, London,
Friday 22nd March - Saturday 23rd March 2024

We would like you to submit an abstract to put forward for an iposter to be presented at the IPM conference in March 2024.

We are calling for abstracts within the following categories:

- Psychosexual Service development within your specialty (this could include innovation, evaluation, quality improvement, audit, a patient experience project, or related to measuring outcomes)
- Addressing psychosexual concerns of people with complex physical and mental health conditions and those with a disability
- Consideration of cultural differences, diversity, race, gender and sexuality in psychosexual therapy within your practice
- Education and Training relating to the IPM approach (research, projects and initiatives that highlight IPM skills and training)

The poster can be in either of the following formats:

- **Research or a project** following the format: *Introduction* (include the problem you are trying to address) *Method* (or how you set up and delivered the project), *Results* (what you found) *Discussion* (what you consider important, relevant and what are your next steps) *Conclusion*
- **Reflection and application of IPM learning and skills** following the format: *Overview* (this could include a case(s) or situation that contributed to your learning and practice) *Summary* (brief description of the case(s) and your reflections), *Discussion* (exploring your reflections and application to learning), *Conclusions* (what conclusions do you draw and how might they relate to practice, theory or policy).

Important dates:

Abstracts open 31/10/23
Abstracts close by 5pm 19/01/24
Acceptance notification to authors week commencing 05/02/24
Posters finalised and back to IPM deadline 11/03/24

All abstracts will be judged on:

- Quality and clarity of the abstract
- Originality of the work
- Contribution to practice
- Innovative and reflection

Accepted abstracts will be developed into iposters to be displayed at the ASM, they will also be considered for oral presentation on Friday 22nd March 2024.

There will be an opportunity to have your poster published in the IPMJ in 2024.

There will be a winning poster for each category. There will also be an award for best poster from each discipline: Medical professionals, Nurse or AHP and best student.

Abstracts can be from one or multiple authors from one or multiple organisations. All successful submitters will be required to register to attend the IPM Annual Scientific Meeting 2024.

We very much value the contributions of those who submit.
